The 29th International Nuclear Physics Conference (INPC 2025) will be held in Daejeon, Korea on May 25-30, 2025. It is hosted by the Center for Exotic Nuclear Studies (CENS) and the Center for Underground Physics (CUP) at the Institute for Basic Science (IBS) and the Center for Extreme Nuclear Matters (CENuM) at Korea University. The INPC series is overseen by the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP).

We are currently receiving abstracts for INPC 2025 opened on October 1, Call for Abstracts 2024. Abstracts can be submitted until November 30, 2024. All submissions will be reviewed by session conveners and the Scientific Committee, and notifications of acceptance will be sent between February 3 and February 10, 2025.

Conference registration opened on November 1, 2024. Early registration is Registration Fee available until May 31, 2025. All registrations for INPC 2025 will be handled through the Indico platform.

The registration fee includes access to the welcome reception on May 25. lunch on May 26-27, the conference banquet on May 29, and light refreshments during poster sessions. Accompanying persons may also register and will receive a name badge, conference goodies, lunch on May 26-27, and access to both the welcome reception and banquet.

Venue





Established in 2008, the Daejeon Convention Center (DCC) is located next to the Daejeon Expo Science Park. DCC is both accessible and appropriately remote from the busiest sectors of Daejeon, offering an immersive and comfortable experience for the conference participants. Numerous conferences and conventions are held regularly at DCC, which features a grand ballroom, an exhibition hall, and 20 meeting rooms of various sizes for all sessions of the scientific program of INPC 2025. Accommodation



Approximately 810 rooms in various hotels near the conference venue have been secured for INPC 2025 participants. Starting November 1, you can book rooms at hotels within a 3-minute walking distance from DCC: I-Hotel, Hotel ICC, and Lotte City Hotel Daejeon, or at hotels within a 15-minute drive, such as Good Morning Residence Hotel HUE and Residence Hotel Line. Shuttle bus service will be available for participants staying at hotels located outside the walking distance.

Additionally, around three more hotels within a 15-minute drive will become available for reservations in early January. Please do not be anxious if you are unable to book rooms well in advance.

If traveling from countries with visa-free status with Korea, participants Travel should apply for a Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) before boarding the flight or ship destined for Korea. Once approved, the K-ETA is valid for 3 years and can be re-used for future visits. Recent visitors with K-ETA may check the validity of the existing authorization. Note that the duration of K-ETA is independent from the permitted number of days for short-term visits to Korea.

On the other hand, participants from certain countries may require a visa to travel to Korea. Please plan your visa application in advance, so that the visa may be granted on time.

Please indicate your preferences through the registration process as early as possible; the deadline is March 31, 2025, 23:59 KST. Reservations for excursions will be made on a first-come first-served basis.

Social Events

The following social events are planned:



- Registration and welcome reception in the afternoon and evening of May 25. Finger food, snacks and light dishes will be provided.
- Poster session in the afternoon of May 27. Snacks, fruits and beverages will be provided.
- Excursion in the afternoon of May 28. For those taking part in excursions, meal options will depend on the excursion choice.
- Dinner banguet accompanied by entertainment performance in the evening of May 29. The banquet will be in the form of an inclusive buffet or a course meal.



A wide range of food and beverages will be served at INPC 2025. Within **Diet** walking distance from the conference venue, there are numerous restaurants featuring both Korean and international cuisines. A famous bakery in Korea, present only in Daejeon called "Sung Sim Dang" is also in close proximity. Participants with special dietary restrictions and conditions may contact the LOC, and they will be accommodated through the contracted Professional Conventional Organizer (PCO).

Prizes and Support



At INPC 2025, winners of the IUPAP Early Career Scientist Prize 2025 will be announced and will present their achievements. In addition, awards for the best oral presentation and poster presentations of student participants will be given.

Through the support by the IUPAP C-12 commission, students and earlycareer scientists requiring financial support for participating in INPC 2025 are encouraged to submit applications to the LOC. The procedure is as follows:

- Submit an abstract for a scientific contribution and provide the abstract
- Register to the conference and provide a registration number.
- Provide evidence of origin.
- Submit a list of recent publications.
- Describe briefly your need for financial support.

Please note that not all requests for financial support will be granted, and individual support will not cover all the expenses.
