The 29<sup>th</sup> International Nuclear Physics Conference (INPC 2025) will be held in Daejeon, Korea on May 25-30, 2025. It is hosted by the Center for Exotic Nuclear Studies (CENS) and the Center for Underground Physics (CUP) at the Institute for Basic Science (IBS) and the Center for Extreme Nuclear Matters (CENuM) at Korea University. The INPC series is overseen by the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP).


# Airport Bus Ticket Purchase (Daejeon to Incheon International Airport Terminal 1, Terminal 2)

For your convenient journey, on-site ticket booking from Daejeon to Incheon International Airport is available at the venue. Please visit the Help Desk to make a payment. Our staff will assist you with the booking process, and your ticket will be sent to you via email. 
# Terminal 1 - By Limousine Bus

Terminal 2 - By Limousine Bus Bus stop & Ticket box location



- 3. Take a taxi from Daejeon Station to the Daejeon Convention Center (DCC).




# Floor Plan








#### **Directions**

# 1. Page Limits

Each presentation type has a maximum page limit as follows (tentative)

- Keynote Talks: up to 20 pages
- Plenary Talks: up to 12 pages
- Invited Talks: up to 6 pages
- Contributed Oral Presentations: up to 4 pages
- Contributed Poster Presentations: up to 2 pages

# 2. Schedule (tentative)

- Proceedings Submission Begins: September 1, 2025
- Proceedings Submission Deadline: October 30, 2025
